- 7) How far is the king's dominion going to reach? (Zech. 9:9)

- 8) For what reason does God say He has set the "prisoners free from the waterless pit"? (Zech. 9:11)

- 9) To where are the prisoners to return? (Zech. 9:12)

- 10) What will God do with Judah and Ephraim? Against whom will He use them? (Zech. 9:13)

- 11) What will the Lord do in that day? (Zech. 9:16)
